### FROM THE BOARD:

Pine Ridge has had an absolutely excellent year. Our community has thrived and been able to grow even in the face of a challenge or two. Inflation, insurance premium increases, and the cost of goods skyrocketing have all added to the difficult decisions that needed to be made to balance our costs versus expectations. The Board has successfully budgeted another year with a small average increase of only 2.9% to our monthly fees. This modest increase keeps with the goal of being able to grow our community while maintaining affordable fees for our residents. We were able to add a back-up generator to the Community Center, enabling all of us to have an emergency resource in case of a power outage or situation. Air conditioning was added to the gym for the convenience of residents and guests who use the Center for activities or events. The hot water system was updated to be more efficient and safe than the old unit. Painting, power washing, and other maintenance projects were significant this year as were landscaping and other capital projects. Our reserves are again healthier than ever. We thank everyone in the community who works daily to make sure we have a shining example of what a condominium community should be.
