FROM THE BOARD:

The refresh and update for the Community Center has been met with an extremely warm welcome. Many people who have used it recently have commented how amazing it looks and how happy they are with the results. A special thank you to Carl Sommers and Dave Fiegl for the amount of time that they put into this project.

You may have noticed that the landscape cleanup project from last year's tree removal has been completed and we hope to see fresh green grass here soon.

We are welcoming a new custodian/cleaner to improve and enhance the look and longevity of the Community Center. Please welcome her and introduce yourself should you be at the Center for an event or activity.

The power washing project will begin shortly. We will be working with a contractor to do our power washing program. Each condo and all surrounding concrete will be washed once every 3 years. Per the contractor, residents can pay a \$20 fee to have furniture and other items moved prior to power washing and then replaced. The moved items will not be cleaned, only moved. If you would like items moved, your request must be made in advance (by contacting Colleen at the office) or that area cannot be cleaned. The contractor is not responsible for any moved items. Also, variance-related items (added fencing, pergolas, etc.) can be cleaned for an additional cost. Zone #3 (Sequoia East/West and Pine Ridge Parkway) will be completed in mid-April this year. Anyone outside Zone #3 (anywhere other than Sequoia and the two condos on Pine Ridge Parkway) wanting to have your condo power washed this year, please call the office and have Colleen put your name on the list. The cost will be around \$100. You must have your name added to the list BY APRIL 10th if you want your condo washed this year. If we get at least 10 people other than those in Zone #3 that sign up, then those condos will be washed immediately following completion of the Zone #3 work. Zone #1 (Pond View, Meadow, Spruce and Monika's unit) will be completed in 2026 and Zone #2 (Evergreen and Cypress) in 2027. The project will follow this rotation moving forward.
